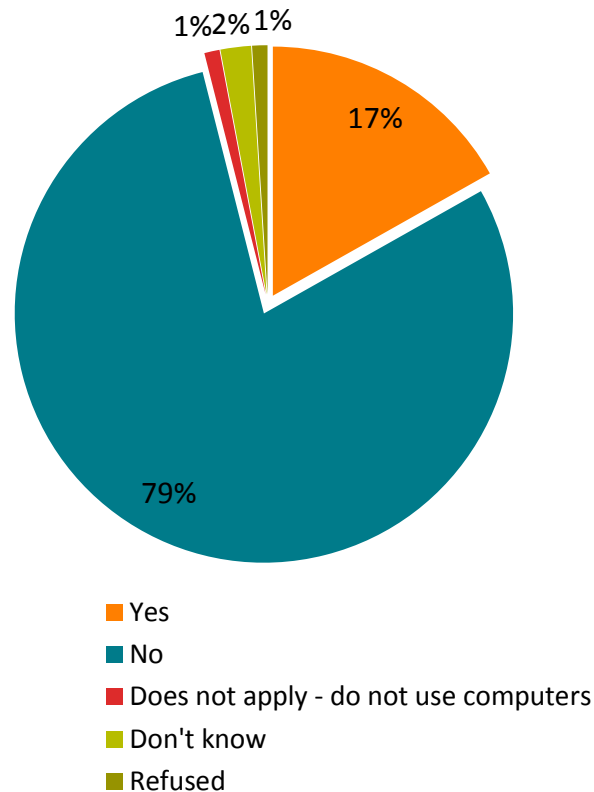

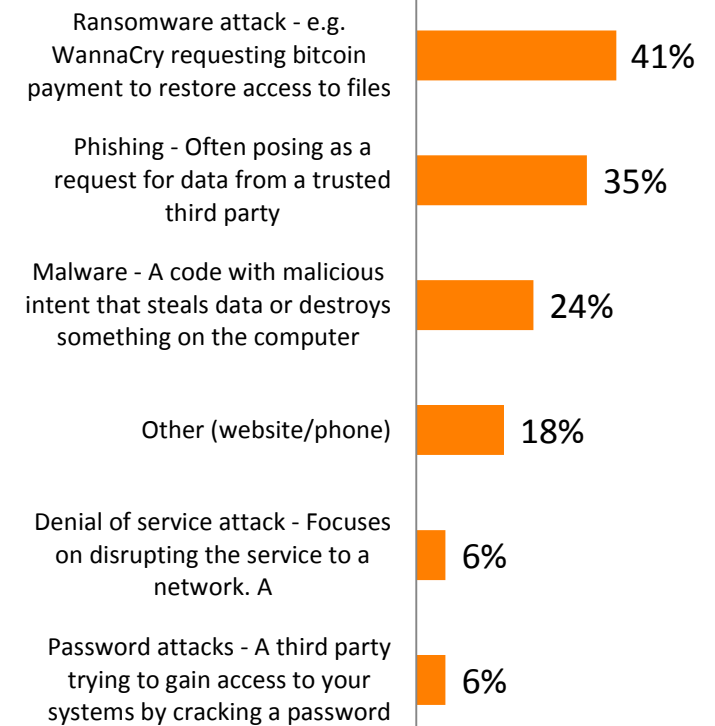
- Increasing risk and charities can be vulnerable

Has your charity ever experienced a cyber attack?



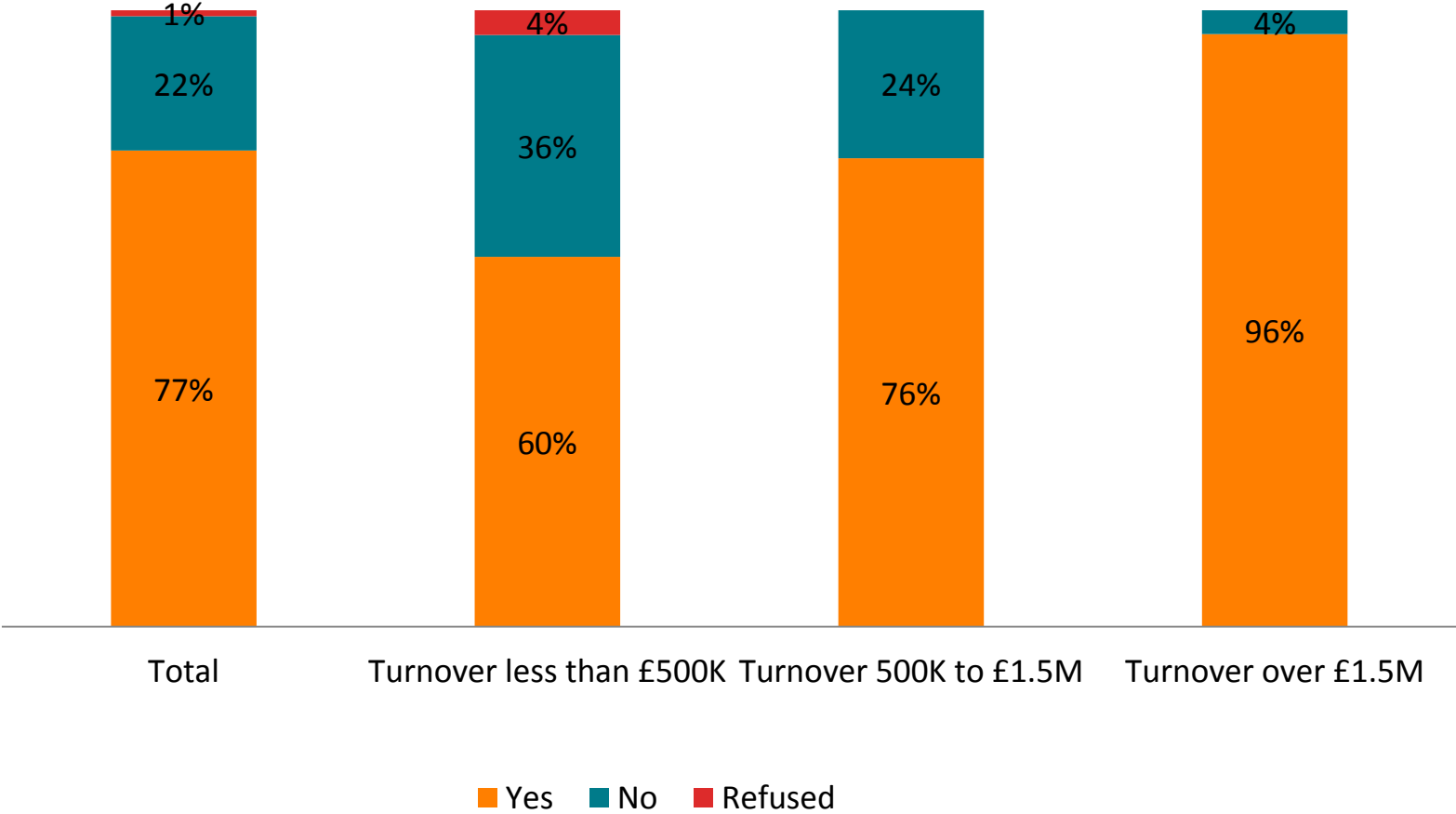
Which of the following type(s) of cyber-attack was it?

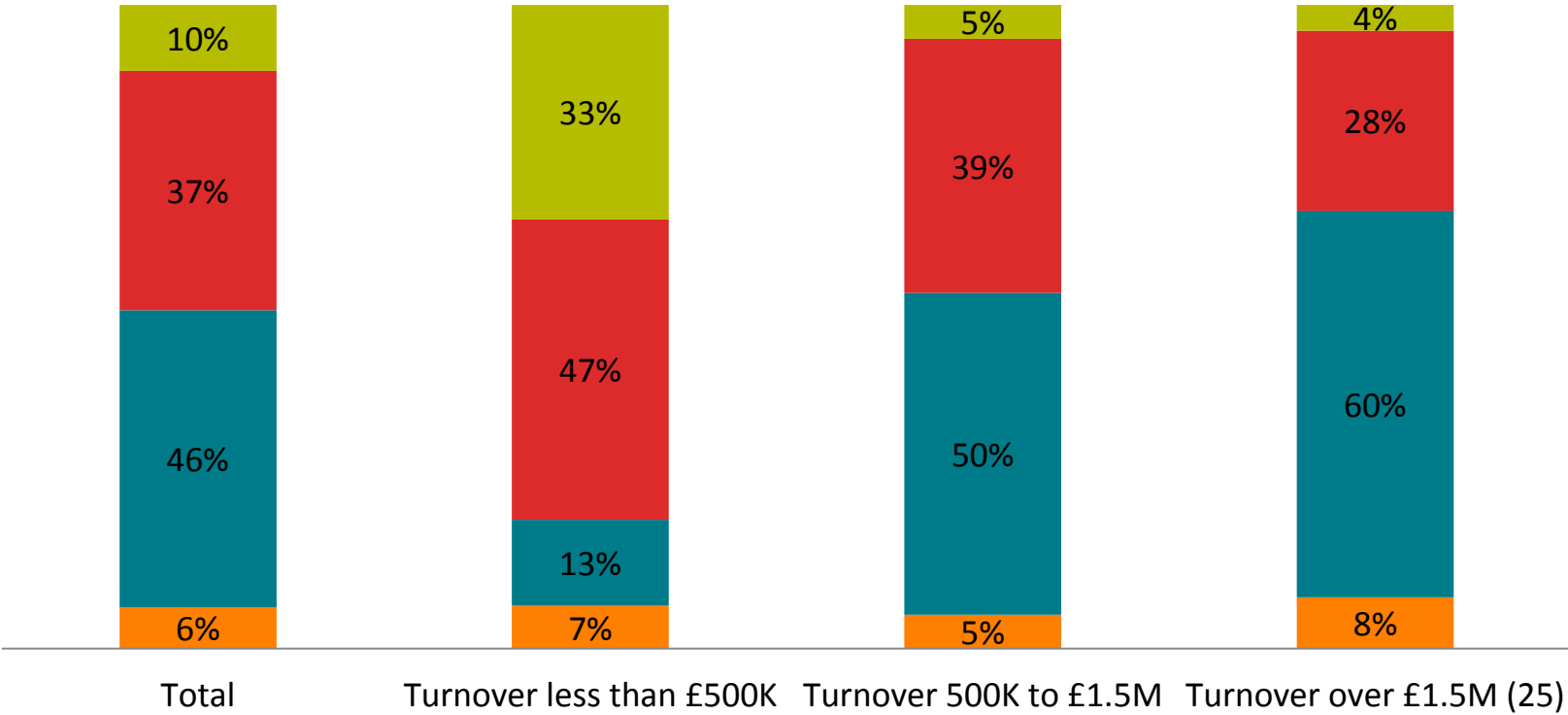

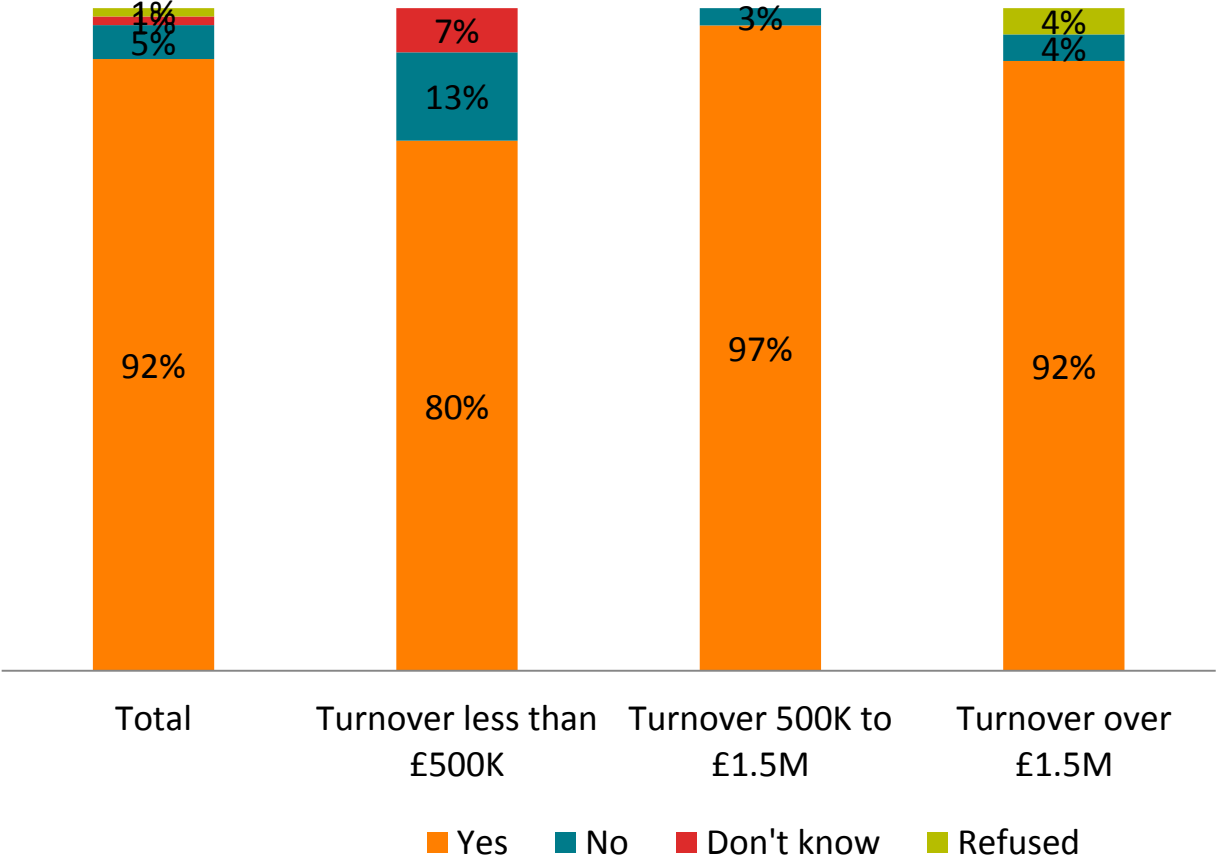
How would you rate your level of knowledge about the impact GDPR will have on your charity?

Do you think your charity will be ready to comply with the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) when it is introduced in May 2018?



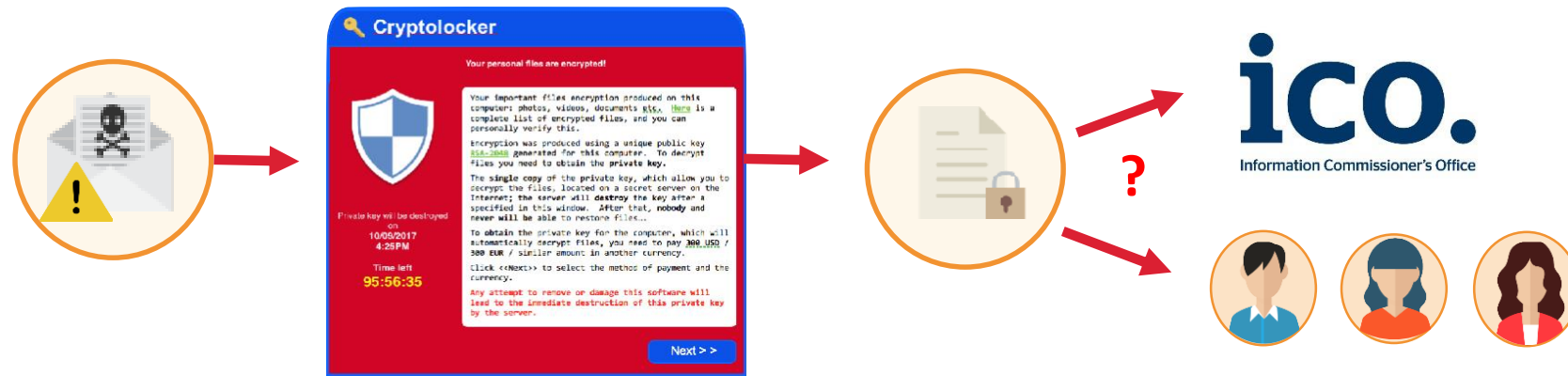
The main barrier for not being ready:

We don't know enough about what the changes to regulation will mean for us

We don't know where to go for advice and guidance

GDPR

- First major change in data legislation since 1998
- Consent debate important but only one part of GDPR
- New data breach notification regulations



- Fair processing & Privacy Notices
- Fines regime

Risks - Management

Cyber Security

- Review Risk Management Plans
- Basic IT security protections (e.g.. patches, firewalls)
- Government Support
- Charity Support
- Cyber Insurance



GDPR

- ICO advice (guidance on consent)
- Review data strategy and governance
- Review all data held and update policies
- Incident notification and recovery plans



Conclusion

- **Take seriously and manage data effectively - but no need to panic!**
- **Review what data is held and where it is shared**
- **Basis of processing and consent**
- **Keep data secure and plan for worst case scenario**
- **Get advice where needed**



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
